REGULAR MEETING

January 4, 2022 @ 5:30 P.M.

The Laurens County Board of Commissioners held their regularly scheduled meeting on Tuesday, January 4, 2022 at 5:30 p.m. Present were, Chairman Kevin Tanner, Commissioners Trae Kemp, Brenda Chain, Jeff Davis, and Jimmy Rogers.
