

LAURENS COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

CALLED MEETING

MARCH 25, 2019 @ 5:30 P.M.

The Laurens County Board of Commissioners held a called meeting on Tuesday, March 25, 2019 at 12:00 P.M. Present were Chairman Trae Kemp, Commissioners Brenda Chain, Kevin Tanner, Jimmy Rogers, County Administrator Bryan Rogers, and County Attorney Billy Kight. Commissioner Jeff Davis was out of town.

The first issue to be discussed was for the Commissioners to approve the GDOT resolution for re-marking the airport. County Administrator Rogers informed the Board that bids had been taken for the re-marking and the price would be \$233,445.50. The GDOT resolution would state that the Commissioners support the project and agree to pay the local share in the amount of \$21,335.12. Commissioner Chain made a motion to approve the resolution for the local share as presented. Commissioner Tanner seconded the motion. All voted in favor of the motion.

The second item discussed was the purchase of the 1 acre tract of land from Jeff Shepard adjacent to Springdale Park for the purpose of constructing an EMS substation. County Attorney Billy Kight explained to the board the purchase price of the property was \$17,500. Commissioner Tanner made a motion to approve the purchase as presented. Commissioner Chain seconded the motion. All voted in favor of the motion.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
