

LAURENS COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

REGULAR MEETING

June 7, 2022 @ 5:30 P.M.

The Laurens County Board of Commissioners held their regularly scheduled meeting on Tuesday, June 7, 2022 at 5:30 p.m. Present were, Chairman Kevin Tanner, Commissioners Brenda Chain, Jimmy Rogers, Jeff Davis, Trae Kemp, County Administrator Bryan Rogers and County Attorney Billy Kight. Commissioner Jimmy Rogers gave the invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance.

The first item was the approval of the minutes of the May 3, 2022 regular meeting minutes. Commissioner Brenda Chain made a motion to approve the regular meeting minutes. Commissioner Jeff Davis seconded the motion. All voted in favor.

The next item was the approval of the Lowery Firehouse Road Bid. Scruggs had the lowest bid of \$3.25 per square yard. Commissioner Trae Kemp made the motion to approve the Lowery Firehouse Road resurfacing bid. Commissioner Jimmy Rogers seconded the motion. All voted in favor.

The next item was the approval of the Intergovernmental Annexation Agreement with the City of Dublin. The property is not contiguous with city property so they cannot annex the property without the County's permission. The Pickle Barrel restaurant located at 2047 Hwy 441 south needs water and sewer from the city for their new building. Commissioner Jeff Davis made the motion to approve the Intergovernmental Agreement. Commissioner Trae Kemp seconded the motion. All voted in favor.

The next item was the Discussion/Approval of Southern Pines Capital Improvements. The Recreation Authority has asked for \$5,000,000 to perform several large capital improvement projects at Southern Pines to include turfing the fields, building pickle ball courts, and new playground equipment. Commissioner Jeff Davis made the motion to approve the Southern Pines Capital Improvements project. Commissioner Brenda Chain seconded the motion. Commissioners Jeff Davis, Brenda Chain, and Trae Kemp voted in favor. Commissioners Kevin Tanner and Jimmy Rogers voted no. The motion passed.

The next item was to approve the Surplus of Equipment. There are several vehicles and equipment listed that are on the Public Works yard that need to be declared surplus. Commissioner Jimmy Rogers made the motion to Surplus the Equipment on the list. Commissioner Trae Kemp seconded the motion. All voted in favor.
