

# LAURENS COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

## REGULAR MEETING

**August 4, 2020 @ 5:30 P.M.**

The Laurens County Board of Commissioners held their regularly scheduled meeting on Tuesday, August 4 at 5:30 p.m. Present were, Chairman Brenda Chain, Commissioners Trae Kemp, Jimmy Rogers, and Kevin Tanner, and County Attorney Billy Kight. Commissioner Jeff Davis and County Administrator Bryan Rogers were absent. Commissioner Trae Kemp gave the invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance.

The first item was the approval of the minutes of the July 7, 2020 regular meeting. Commissioner Trae Kemp made a motion to approve the regular meeting minutes. Commissioner Jimmy Rogers seconded the motion. All voted in favor.

The next item was to approve the Annexation Intergovernmental Agreement with City of Dublin. Emmett Black has requested annexation of his 6.42-acre tract of land located at the intersection of Pinehill Road and Hwy 441 into the City of Dublin. They have planned a commercial development that will require water and sewer. Joshua Kight spoke on their behalf to explain the Intergovernmental Agreement. Since this parcel is not contiguous with the city limits, the only way it can happen is through an Intergovernmental Agreement. The construction time line is to have it complete by the end of 2021. Commissioner Trae Kemp made the motion to approve the Annexation Intergovernmental Agreement with City of Dublin. Commissioner Kevin Tanner seconded the motion. All voted in favor.

The next item was the VA Presentation. Keith Griffin presented a power point presentation on a Fisher House at the VA. The home will be available to families of patients that have extended stays at the VA. It will be free of charge for families and can stay as long as needed. They have the land needed for the Fisher House.

The next item was to approve the surplus vehicles for the Sheriff's Department. Alan Baggett spoke and said the vehicles had high miles. Two of them were 2014 Dodge Charger's and the other was the 2012 Ford truck. Commissioner Trae Kemp made the motion to approve the surplus of the vehicles. Commissioner Kevin Tanner second the motion. All voted in favor.

### OTHER BUSINESS:

Royce Hall with the City of Dublin spoke about the census. He would like to encourage everyone to fill out the census. The deadline is September 30, 2020.
