

LAURENS COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

CALLED MEETING

September 28, 2022 @ 12:00 P.M.

The Laurens County Board of Commissioners held a called meeting on Wednesday, September 28, 2022 at 12:00 P.M. Present were Chairman Jimmy Rogers, Commissioners Kevin Tanner, Brenda Chain, Trae Kemp, Jeff Davis and County Administrator Bryan Rogers and County Attorney Billy Kight.

The first issue to be discussed was to adopt the 2022 Millage Rate. The Board of Education's millage rate is 14.485 mills and the County's roll back millage rate of 6.754 mills for a total millage rate of 21.239 mills. Commissioner Trae Kemp made a motion to approve the 2022 Millage Rate. Commissioner Jeff Davis seconded the motion. All voted in favor of the motion.

CITIZEN COMMENTS

Glen Warnock with Gay Wood Company asked the Board of Commissioners to take a mutual stance on the weight of the trucks on state roads. It is currently 84,000 pounds and he would like it increased to 90,000 pounds. Chairman Kevin Tanner stated that they would consider it and let him know.
